Trips for Advanced

Saverton, Missouri/Lock & Dam 22 to Clarksville, Missouri/Lock & Dam 24

Louisiana to Clarksville:

Make it a day or stay overnight. Paddlers can explore the lower section of the water trail, have a picnic lunch on an island, and experience locking through at Locks and Dam 24. Primitive camping areas are located along the trail, if a multi-day adventure is desired.

Saverton to Louisiana:

This trip will require shuttling to Saverton boat ramp. An adventure awaits on this pristine section of trail that encourages adventure and exploration.

Saverton to Dupont Access:

This trip will take half a day and is sure to provide adventure for the paddler.

Dupont Access to Louisiana:

Take time to explore and have a picnic lunch on the large sand island. This trip is an all day adventure.

Louisiana to Paddlers Pass:

Enjoy the mighty Mississippi by experiencing Paddlers Pass. This unique area between two islands provides perfect water for practicing your paddling skills. It also provides a nice shady place for a picnic lunch or observing paddlers as they practice their skills.

Note: Paddling times may vary based on river conditions, weather and the paddler's ability.
